<b>like</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• comme</li> <li>• de même genre</li> </ul>	The weather in Scotland is like the one in Ireland.
<b>alike</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• semblable</li> <li>• pareil</li> </ul>	The two cousins look alike.
<b>in the same way</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• de la même manière</li> <li>• de la même façon</li> </ul>	All the people in this street think in the same way.
<b>the same as</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• le même que</li> <li>• la même que</li> </ul>	She is the same opinion as my parents.
<b>as well as</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ainsi que</li> <li>• aussi bien que</li> </ul>	My brother speaks French as well as her.
<b>in comparison to in comparison with</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• par rapport à</li> </ul>	In comparison with Russia, Belgium is small.
<b>too</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• aussi</li> </ul>	They like coffee. Me too
<b>in a similar way</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• d'une manière similaire</li> <li>• de la même façon</li> </ul>	Our cat is fed in a similar way.
<b>similarly</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• de la même manière</li> </ul>	The twins were similarly dressed.
